- celery or carrot parsnip juices – this is very effective for digestion, and helping the body repair and fight disease
- If your pet does not eat his food, simply remove it after a while as doing this will also aid the detoxification process
- Exercise your pet regularly to encourage bowel movements and get rid of excess toxins and poisons
- Steer clear of using chemically-based cleaners, detergents, flea powders and insecticides as pets often inhale the harsh fumes and toxins
- Avoid smoking around your pet, if you do – use a humidifier in our home
- Massage and brush your pet's coat regularly to promote blood circulation and help toxins move through the pores
- Avoid giving pet's food or water in plastic bowls, rather use stainless steel, glass or porcelain
- Cook food in stainless-steel pans rather than copper or aluminium pots or pans
